Minutes of Called Meeting Elbert County Board of Commissioners Thursday, August 20, 2020

Chairman Lee Vaughn called the meeting to order. Present were Chairman Vaughn, Vice Chairman Kenneth Ashworth, Commissioner Horace Harper, Commissioner Casey Freeman, Commissioner Chris Alexander, Commissioner Freddie Jones, County Administrator Bob Thomas, County Attorney Bill Daughtry, County Clerk Tamara Butler and CFO Phil Pitts.

After the pledge to the United States flag the invocation was given by Commissioner Ashworth.

Adoption of Agenda. Chairman Vaughn asked for a motion to amend the agenda to add an Executive Session. Commissioner Freeman made the motion to amend the agenda and approve the agenda as amended. Commissioner Alexander seconded the motion. Upon voting the motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and approval to name Daniel Dobbins as Elbert County's representative to the Joint Development Authority of Northeast Georgia. This appointment is for a 2-year term beginning July 1, 2020. This authority comprises Athens-Clarke, Barrow, Elbert, Jackson, Madison, Oconee, and Oglethorpe Counties. Commissioner Freeman made the motion to approve Daniel Dobbins. Commissioner Jones seconded the motion. Upon voting the motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and approval of a contract with KCI Technologies, Inc. for a non-destructive pavement condition evaluation on approximately 420 centerline miles of county roadways in Elbert County. The field inspection will be conducted in accordance to guidelines established by the Georgia DOT for the maintenance of our roadway system. Jimmy Witherow and Joe Barron with KCI Technologies were on hand to answer questions and Mr. Witherow gave a presentation of the system that they used to evaluate roads. Commissioner Jones made a motion to approve the contract with KCI Technologies. Commissioner Ashworth seconded the motion. Upon voting the motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and approval to bid on nine (9) mobile homes that are delinquent in taxes and should be removed from the property. These mobile homes are scheduled to be sold on the first Tuesday in September 2020 (September 1, 2020). Commissioner Ashworth made a motion to approve for the county to bid on the mobile homes that are delinquent in taxes. Commissioner Freeman seconded the motion. Upon voting the motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and approval to increase the purchase amount of a used vehicle for the EMS, First Responder and EMA programs to \$25,000. This is a request for an additional \$5,000 which Mr. Thomas stated would help in finding a better vehicle for the EMS department. Commissioner Harper made a motion to approve. Commissioner Jones seconded the motion. Upon voting the motion carried 5-0.

Discussion regarding county offices at the Beaverdam School building in response to the Board of Education's facility options. Our contract expires May 31, 2023. Mr. Thomas stated the BOE has said that 4-H is important to the school program and wants it to continue to be close to the school.

Discussion of the proposed changes to Chapter 38 of the Code of Ordinances regarding mobile homes and travel trailers and camping sites. Mr. Allen Hulme stated some changes include adding a definition

of a travel trailer, general installation standards, setbacks of 100 ft. from right-of-way; adding a section that addresses storage of unoccupied travel trailers and site sizes. No vote required; as this will first go before the planning commission for approval and then for first reading at the next monthly meeting.

Discussion and approval to declare certain vehicles and equipment as surplus by the EMS Department and Road Department. Mr. Thomas stated there were vehicles and equipment from the Road Department and EMS to add as surplus items to either be sold by sealed bid, auction or on gov deals.
